

Pre-Proposal Questions and Answers

Q. What about determining eligibility for services from the Developmental Disabilities Administration for an individual with court involvement entering their service from a court?

Ans. A representative from the appropriate regional office of the Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) will determine the eligibility for services from the DDA. We will expedite the eligibility process for individuals who are committed to the Department of Health & Mental Hygiene and admitted to a forensic residential center or community provider for evaluation.

Q. Should we assume the court involved individual is waiver eligible?

No, one should not automatically assume one is waiver eligible. First must make certain that the individual has been determined eligible for services from the DDA.

Q. When will the MAPS-MD assessment be completed for the individual?

Ans. Upon receipt of the Application for Services for the Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA), the appropriate regional office of the DDA will expedite eligibility process, make a determination of eligibility ("Developmentally Disabled" or Individual Support Services Only." Once eligibility determination made, a referral is made to MAPS-MD to complete the level of need assessment (using the Individual Indicator Rating Scale). The level of need rating score is completed within 10 business days from the date of referral or in emergencies, with 48 hours.

Q. Payment

The services will be rate base.
